Morocco and Tunisia, even if they were only a protectorate, were widely cited and benefit from a collective homage of the head of state by recalling the close relations of these countries "Friends" as a reminded the Chief of Army Hollande.-----

To this François Hollande received His Majesty King Mohamed V of Morocco, during the inauguration of the new IMA tribute Cultural

Center "and the new Moroccan consulate Orly.

The Head of State then shook hands with many guests, settled in tents, many veterans and war survivors including a political journalist, Claude, himself a survivor of the war in Algeria

The weather luck that it has not rained during the ceremony, as often the rain is a frequent guest at many commemorations of Francois Hollande, including this symbolic day in 2012, his inauguration as President of the Republic during the official parade on the Champs Elysee.

It is now a memorial that was necessary being given the proximity to France with Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia after the belated recognition errors committed by France. The coincidence of timing brings a touch is both dramatic and sad, because the next day the ceremony of remembrance, has plunged another friend and very close countries, Belgium in the horror of the attacks.

The explosions of Zaventem airport and Brussels Maelbeek station, have killed 31 people and left three hundred wounded, were claimed by ISIS, which claim to kill in the name of Islam ... Recall that the "true Muslims" had protected France in enlisting in the army.-----
